# Glow in the dark Jellyfish Craft

---



## Materials

- 1 . Heavyweight Paper Towers
2. White yarn
3. Glow in the Dark Acrylic paint Preferred ForkArt Brands
4. Paint Brushes and painting supplies
5. Scissors
6. Zipper sandwich bags
7. Skewers or sharp pencil

## Directions

Paint the bowl inside and out. Use two or more coats of paint for a brighter glow.



For tentacles Cut 10 to 12 pieces of yarn 36 inches in length. Place them in the zipper sandwich bag with several squirts of the glow paint and seal the bag.



Squish until the yarn is completely covered, adding more paint if necessary. If the paint is too thick you can add a little water to the bag.



Hang the yarn to dry.



At the center of the bowl punch two holes about 0.5 inches apart using a skewer or a sharp pencil.



Cut the yarn about 40 inches long. Thread it through The two holes So that both ends come out The bottom of the bowl.



From inside of the bowl, Pull the yarn Up to form a small loop. Thread The tentacles through and roughly Center them under the loop.



Flip The bowl, Pull the yarn taut & tie a double knot.



Back on The inside of the bowl, grasp the tentacles As one bunch and tie a single knot.



The fully appendages Flanking The mouths of some types of jellyfish Are called oval arms. To recreate these, unravel a few pieces Of yarn that hang close to the center of the bunch.



Change your jellyfish Creation in bright light for at least 30 seconds. Turn out the light and enjoy its glow !
