This time allows us to do necessary maintenance, repairs and deep cleaning while the building is empty. Last year, we replaced all the windows in the building with safe, modern, efficient inserts. We did some painting, flooring and upgraded some of our lighting. Earlier this year we upgraded our kitchen facilities. Now we are replacing the flooring throughout the lower level, painting all the first-floor classrooms and offices as well as all the wood trim on the exterior of the building. We're adding to our security systems, creating expanded storage capacity and more. Additionally, as part of our long-term plan we are working with the Village of Tarrytown to enhance our playground equipment and play areas.
